Rental Agreement – Terms and Conditions

1. The hirer is fully responsible for rented winter sports equipment. The equipment must be used in a professional manner at all times during the rental period. It is not permitted to pass on hired equipment to third parties. All winter sports equipment is rented out in a serviceable condition.
2. The adjustment of ski bindings is included in the rental agreement. The completion of the computer check in procedure is an agreement that the hirer confirms authenticity of his/her personal details as used for the professional setting of bindings. The hirer must declare their weight, age, height and skiing ability (beginner, intermediate, expert) on the signed rental agreement. All adjustments will be made according to the information provided by the hirer and to manufacturer's specifications.
3. All ski binding adjustments are regularly checked according to the latest ISO standards using a standard ski binding adjustment machine.
4. Ski binding settings can be manually adjusted at the hirers request free of charge. If you wish to have your ski binding setting adjusted using the ISO standard ski binding machine, this will be an extra cost that must be paid directly to Skiverleih Kurz.
5. All winter sports equipment can only be rented with presentation of a photo identification document such as a driver's licence or personal ID card.
6. There is risk involved with winter sports. Skiverleih Kurz is not liable for any unforeseen event that may occur to you or the equipment during your rental period. A signed rental agreement releases the hirer from making any third party claims.
7. In the event that the equipment is mishandled or damaged, the hirer is liable to pay for any costs for the repair of the damaged items. This cost must be paid directly to Skiverleih Kurz.
8. In the case of loss or theft, the hirer is fully responsible. The hirer must report any such loss to the local Police authorities and rental company, Skiverleih Kurz, immediately. Once the police report has been presented to the rental company, Skiverleih Kurz, the cost of the missing items will be calculated and must then be paid immediately to Skiverleih Kurz.
9. The hirer is able to exchange winter sports equipment within the rental agreement as long as it is in the same hired category or higher. If upgrading to a higher quality, then the difference in rental becomes due according to the current pricelists. Upgrade can be done at any stage of the rental period. It is not possible to change to a lower category.
10. All winter sports equipment must be paid for before returning the items hired. The latest an item can be returned is before 10am the following day. For days when the items are not used, there is no refund. If rented winter sports equipment is not used for reasons of poor weather conditions, lifts not operating or other difficulties, then refunds cannot be given.
11. A refund of unused rental fees is only possible in the event of sickness and/or accident with the presentation of a Doctors Certificate.
